ABOUT XXXII NATIONAL CONFERENCE

The 42nd National Conference of the Nutrition Society of India will be held at the Residence Hotel and Convention Centre, Saki Vihar Road, Before Vihar Lake, Powai, Mumbai, on 19th and 20th November 2010. The theme of the conference is “**Wholesome Nutrition: Challenges, Scope and Management**”

A pre-conference workshop would be conducted on the 18th of November 2010 primarily for student delegates. The topics are “**Instrumentation in Food Analysis – An Update**” and “**Guidelines for Preparation of Manuscript for Publication**”.

HIGHLIGHTS:

➤ **Gopalan Oration:** The Thirty-fourth Gopalan Oration will be delivered by **Prof. DJP Barker**, MRC Environmental Epidemiology Unit, University of Southampton, Southampton General Hospital, Southampton, UK.

➤ **Srikantia Memorial Lecture:** The Twenty-second Srikantia Memorial Lecture will be delivered by **Dr.B.Sivakumar**, Former Director, National Institute of Nutrition (ICMR), Hyderabad.

➤ **Dr. Rajammal P. Devadas Memorial Award:** This year the Society is introducing a new memorial award in the name of (Late) Dr. Rajamal P. Devadas, Former Chancellor, Avinashilingam University for Women, Coimbatore from 2010. The first Dr. Rajamal P. Devadas Memorial Lecture Award will be delivered by **Dr. Mahatab S. Bamji**, INSA Hon. Scientist, Dangoria Charitable Trust, Hyderabad & Director Grade Scientist (Retd.), National Institute of Nutrition, Hyderabad.

Symposium I on “Challenges of Under and Over Nutrition” and
Symposium II on “Approaches to Wholesome Nutrition”

- **Young Scientist's Awards Session:** In the young scientist's awards session, competition for junior and senior awards under community and experimental nutrition will be held. Members desirous of competing for the same should send **4 hard copies** of full paper along with abstract to the **Joint Secretary, Nutrition Society of India, National Institute of Nutrition, Jamai-Osmania PO, Hyderabad – 500604, Andhra Pradesh, India** on/or before **31st August 2010** after which no submissions will be accepted. Abstract of the paper must be submitted in electronic format **by email to nsihyderabad@yahoo.com**. **Criteria and guidelines for submitting paper for award session are available at the NSI websites (www.nutritionocietyindia.org / www.nsimumbai.org).**
- **Free communications and posters:** Members interested in presenting papers in the free communications and posters session category should send **one hard copy** of abstract of the paper with a forwarding letter from the concerned Head of Department / Institute to **Dr.Kasturi Sen Ray, Organizing Chair, 42nd National Conference of NSI, Dept. of Food Science and Nutrition, Dept. of PGSR in Home Science, SNDT Women's University, Santacruz (W), Mumbai 400049.** Abstract must be submitted in electronic format **through 'Online Paper Submission' at**

www.nsimumbai.org. Electronic versions will be accepted only after receipt of the hard copy with a forwarding letter from the concerned Head of Department / institute. **Detailed guidelines for preparation & submitting the abstract for free communications and posters session are available at the NSI websites (www.nutritionocietyindia.org / www.nsimumbai.org).**

- **Best presentations** in the poster session will be awarded the NSI prize, Shri Haveli Ram Pasricha award and Dr.K.Seetharam Bhat Award. The Ramanathan Award will be awarded for best presentation in the free communication session.
- **Pre-Conference Workshop:** A pre-conference Workshop on **"Instrumentation in Food Analysis – An Update"** and **"Guidelines for Preparation of Manuscript for Publication"** primarily for student delegates will be organized on 18th November 2010. The participants may register their names by filling the conference registration form (should include an additional amount of Rs. 500/-) and the same should reach the organizers on/or before the deadline i.e. **30th September 2010.**

- Duly filled registration form (can be downloaded from the NSI website www.nutritionocietyindia.org/ www.nsimumbai.org/) along with registration fee, accommodation deposit etc. should be sent to the Organizing Chair. Registration will be confirmed only on receipt of the registration fee. The registration fee for the participants covers conference documents, lunches, tea and dinner. The deadline for payment of registration fee for the conference without late fee is **30th September 2010**.
- All payments should be made only through Demand Draft drawn in favour of the “NSI Mumbai Chapter” payable at Mumbai. **No cheques (except at par cheques) / IPO will be accepted.**
- In the case of registered delegates who are unable to attend the meetings, 60% of the registration fee will be refunded on receipt of request by the organizers before **31st October 2010**. All the refunds, however, will be disbursed only after the completion of the Conference.
- Reservation for accommodation will be made on receipt of the advance amount along with the registration fee latest by **30th September 2010**. **No reservation will be confirmed without deposit.** Please indicate whether the accommodation is required or not in the registration.
